

Who Wants to Be a Millionaire?

Focusing on Personal Finance & Fiscal Responsibility
A FAST program for 4th-5th grade students
Facilitated by Ms. Neal

When: Wednesdays – (excluding Fall & Thanksgiving breaks and early release days) 12 sessions from 2:30-3:30 p.m.

Dates: August 15 & 22; September 5, 12, 19; October 3, 10, 24, 31; November 7, 14, 28

Where: 607 (Ms. Neal's classroom)

This class focuses on personal finance and responsibility. It's designed to engage children in investing and saving for the future. The goal of this class is to help prepare students for a financially independent future.

Topics of Study:

- Budgeting for today
- Budgeting for the future – (Students will use interest surveys to direct them toward an occupation)
- Gross vs. Net Income – Taxes/Social Security & Medicare
- Compound interest - the good, the bad and the ugly
- The power of time when saving for the future
- Investing and making money work for the investor
- The impact of giving both personally and in the lives of others

A highlight for this class is the **Stock Market Game**; an online simulation where teams of students are given a portfolio of \$100,000 to invest in the global stock market. They explore the fundamentals of investing and sometimes costly markets within a safe environment. Teams research companies using tools from Yahoo Finance, then invest in the stocks of their choice over a ten-week period. Tritt teams will compete with students across the region.

Note: We had two first place teams in the Congressional Sixth District: one from each class in the 2017-18 sessions.

Cost: \$200 per student
